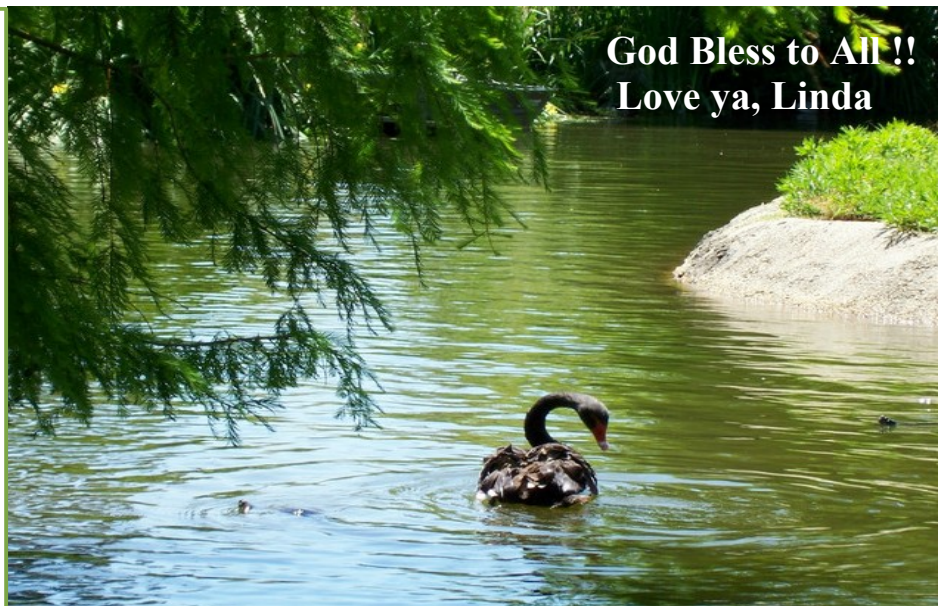
Just a gorgeous day for the Mages Picnic and Camping. The Mages Family concert was great. Your voices are just sweet. What a Joy it was to listen to.

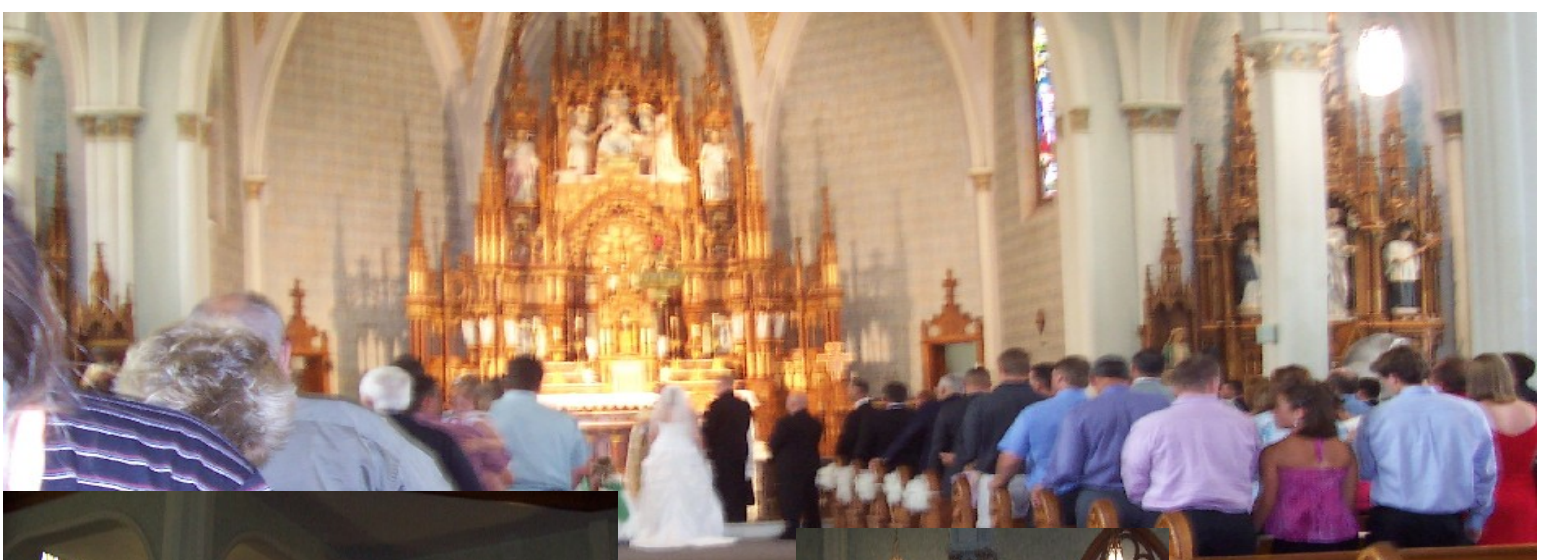

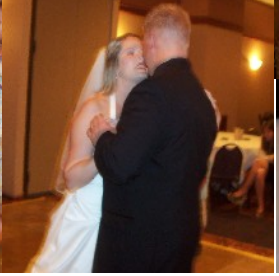
