I am baptized, happy day! All my sins are washed away.




LAUREN MAGES' FIRST COMMUNION







I was eating cookies the other day that Suzanne and Michelle made. The warm cookies jogged my memory of when I was young. When I was growing up we only had one clock on the farm. When I was the youngest boy working outside with my brothers, I would have to run to the house once in a while to check the time so we would know when to come in for the noon meal. Occasionally, Mom would be baking cookies so my job was also to steal a few cookies on each trip to check the time. Some mornings I had to check the time quite frequently.

One of my favorite meals and memories growing up was the noon meal Mom and my sisters made for us on Saturdays in August and September each year. The meal consisted of Roast Beef with mashed potatoes and gravy, cucumbers in cream sauce, corn on the cob, sliced tomatoes, homemade bread, and watermelon or cantaloupe for dessert. All of the above items were fresh from our farm and very delicious. I usually had a tough time deciding whether to top my mashed potatoes with the roast beef gravy or the creamy cucumbers - I usually ate a couple platefuls of food so I did both.
